

BHSI ASSESSMENT	DIRECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS.  All direct entry submissions must be accompanied by a CV and a letter of recommendation from a BHSI assessor or FBHS.
Ride (General)	Extensive experience working practically in the equine industry and a competition record to the level of the BHSI in at least one of the Olympic disciplines.
Coach (General)	Extensive experience working practically in the equine industry including preparing students for qualifications up to and including BHS Stage 4, or equivalent level.
Dressage Ride	Documented evidence of producing and competing a minimum of three horses from Novice to Advanced Medium.
	Riders who have been placed at regional level at Prix St Georges (on one or more horse) will not be required to complete section 3 of the riding assessment.  Riders who have produced and competed two or more horses from Novice to qualifying for Prix St Georges National Championships, will not be required to complete sections 2, 3 and 4 of the riding assessment.
Dressage Coach	Documented evidence of producing a minimum of two horse and rider combinations competing from Novice to Advanced Medium.
Show Jumping Ride	Documented evidence of producing and a competing at least 3 horses from Novice to 1.20m.  Riders who have been placed at 1.30m (on one or more horse) will not be required to complete section 3 of the riding assessment.  Riders who have produced and competed two or more horses from Novice to achieving a minimum of one FEI ranking point will not be required to complete sections 2, 3 & 4 of the riding assessment.
Show Jumping Coach	Documented evidence of producing a minimum of two horse and rider combinations competing from Novice to 1.20m.
Eventing Ride	Documented evidence of producing and competing at least three horses from Novice to 3*.  Riders who have completed M.E.R.'s for 4* (on one or more horse) will not be required to complete section 3 of the riding assessment.  Riders who have produced and competed two or more horses from Novice to 5*, will not be required to complete sections 2, 3 & 4 of the riding assessment.
Eventing Coach	Documented evidence of producing a minimum of two horse and rider combinations competing from Novice to 3*.
Working Horses from the Ground	Demonstrate competencies of Stage 4 Lunge
Stable Management	Demonstrate competencies of Stage 4 Care
Business Management	Demonstrate competencies of Stage 4 Business Management
